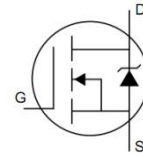

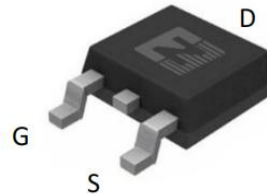

Fig.1 Gate-Charge Characteristics

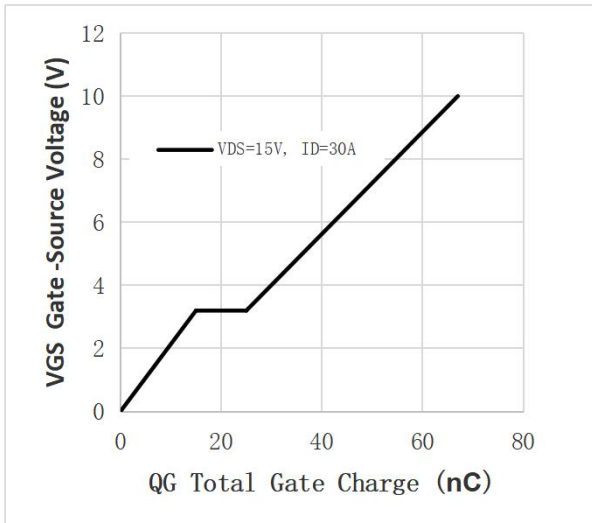


Fig.2 Capacitance Characteristics

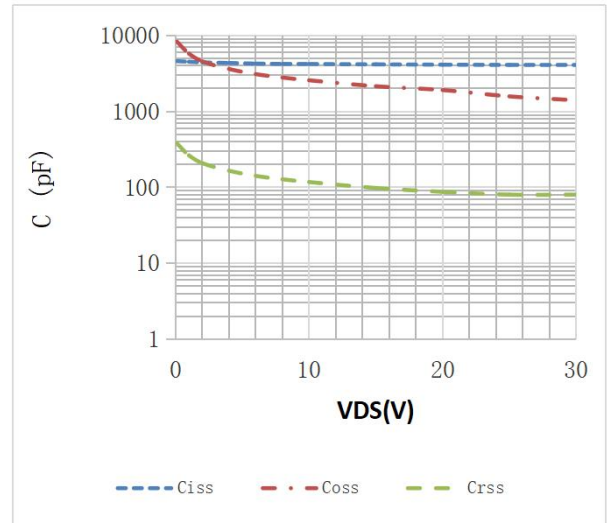


Fig.3 Power Dissipation

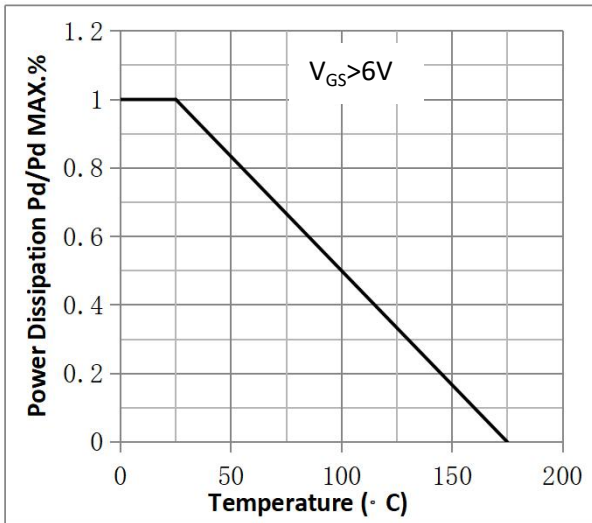


Fig.4 Typical output Characteristics

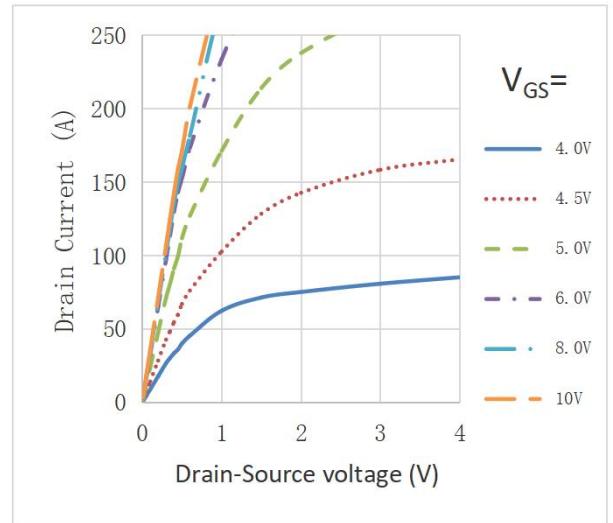


Fig.5 Threshold Voltage V.S Junction Temperature

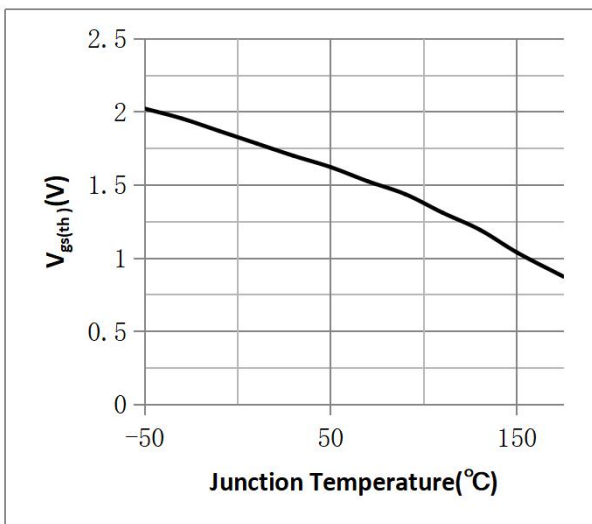


Fig.6 Resistance V.S Drain Current

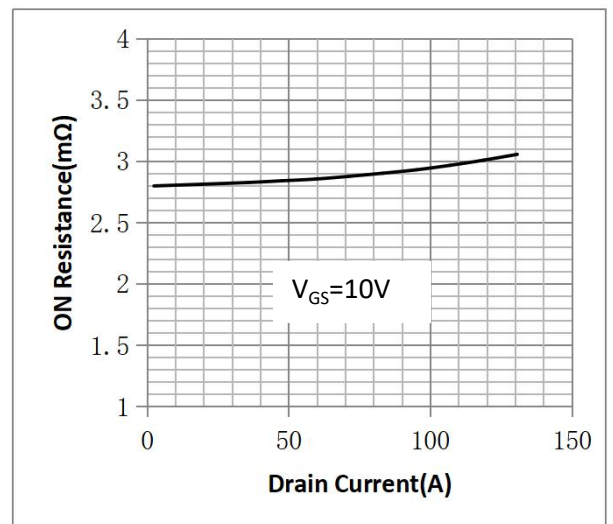


Fig.7 On-Resistance VS Gate Source Voltage

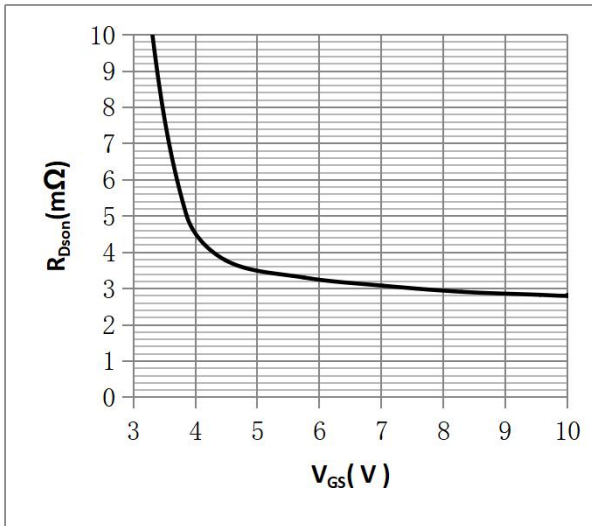


Fig.8 On-Resistance V.S Junction Temperature

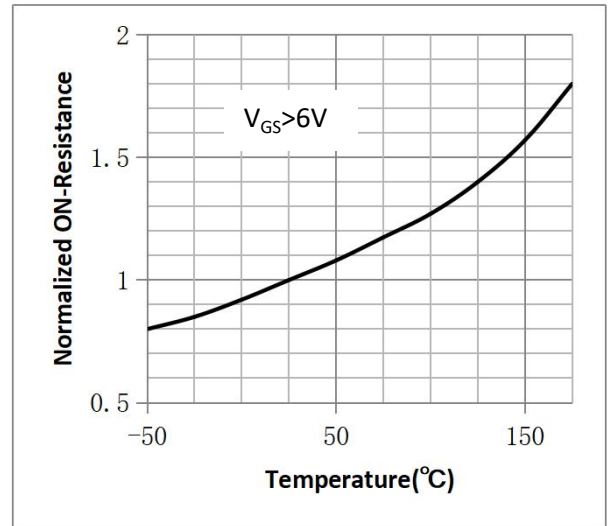


Figure 9. Diode Forward Voltage vs. Current

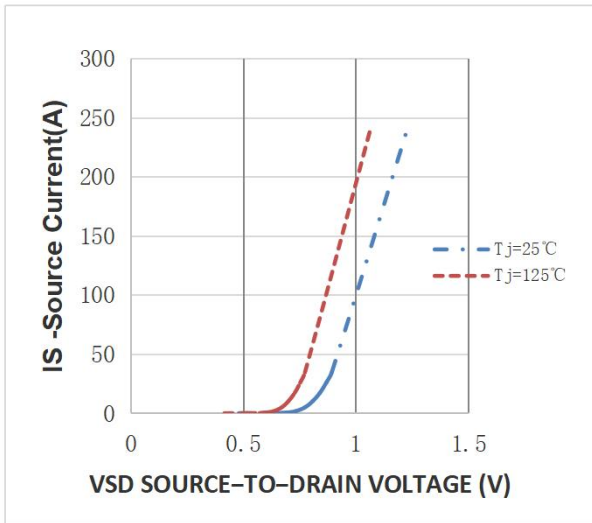


Figure 10. Transfer Characteristics

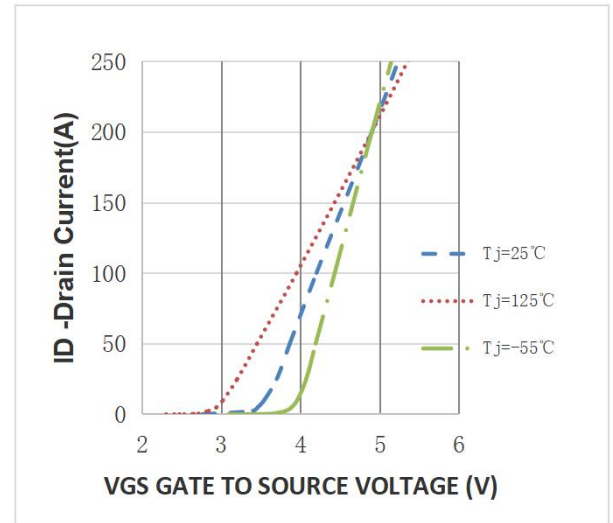


Fig.11 Safe Operating Area

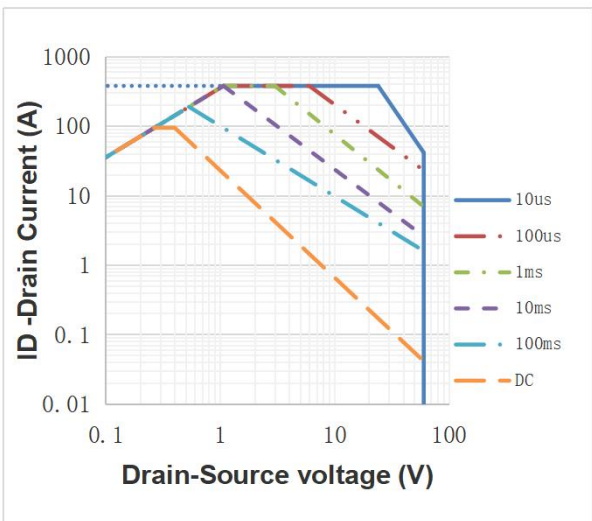
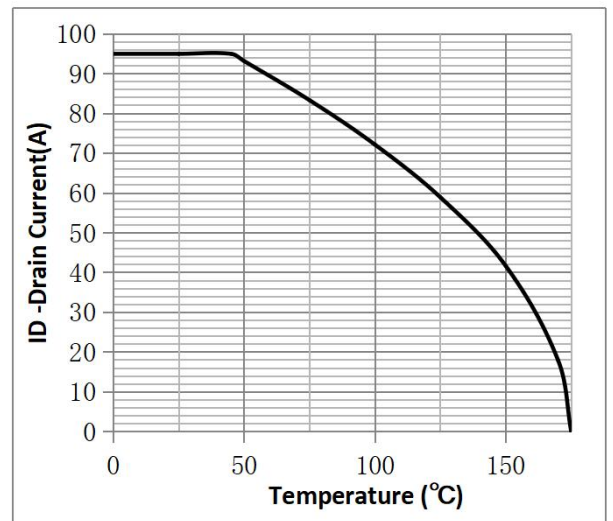
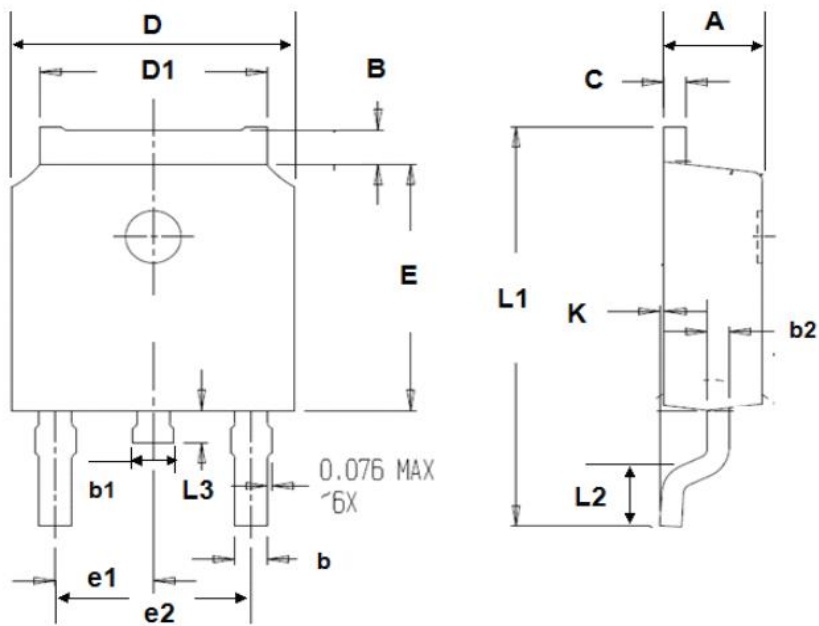


Fig.12 ID vs. Case Temperature<sup>③</sup>
